

How to sign up for access to Broadcast

Step 1: Go to Library homepage and search for Broadcast in the Discover box

Step 2: Click on yellow bar to sign into Discover

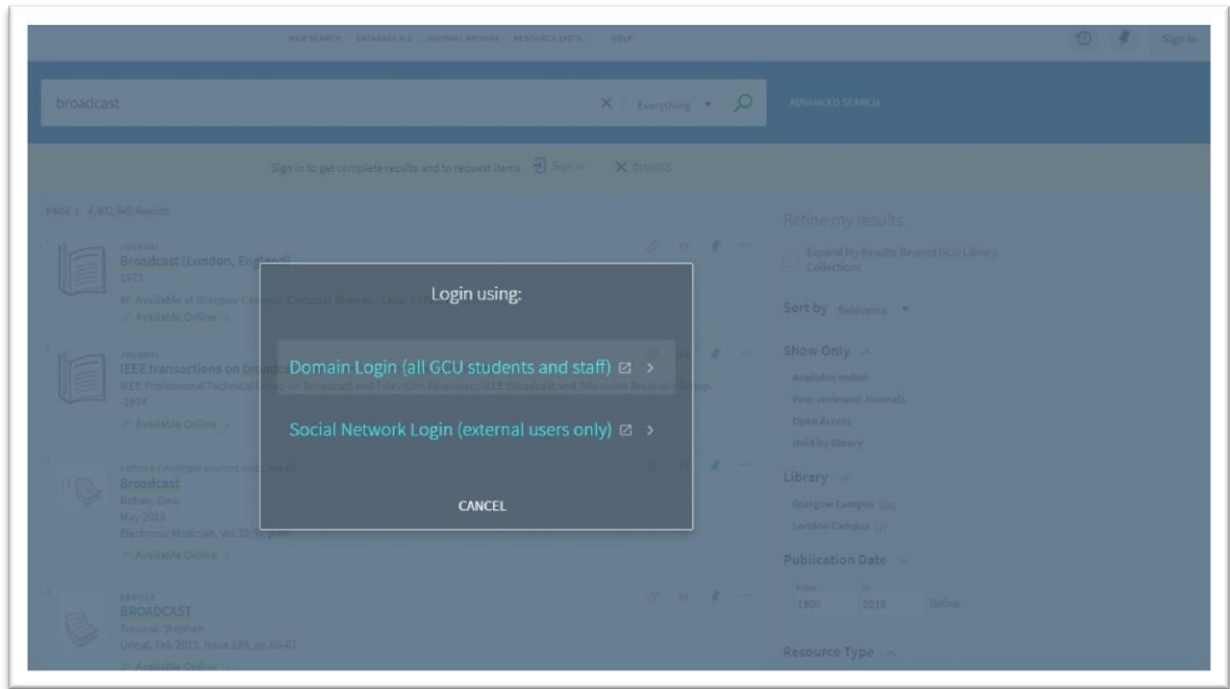

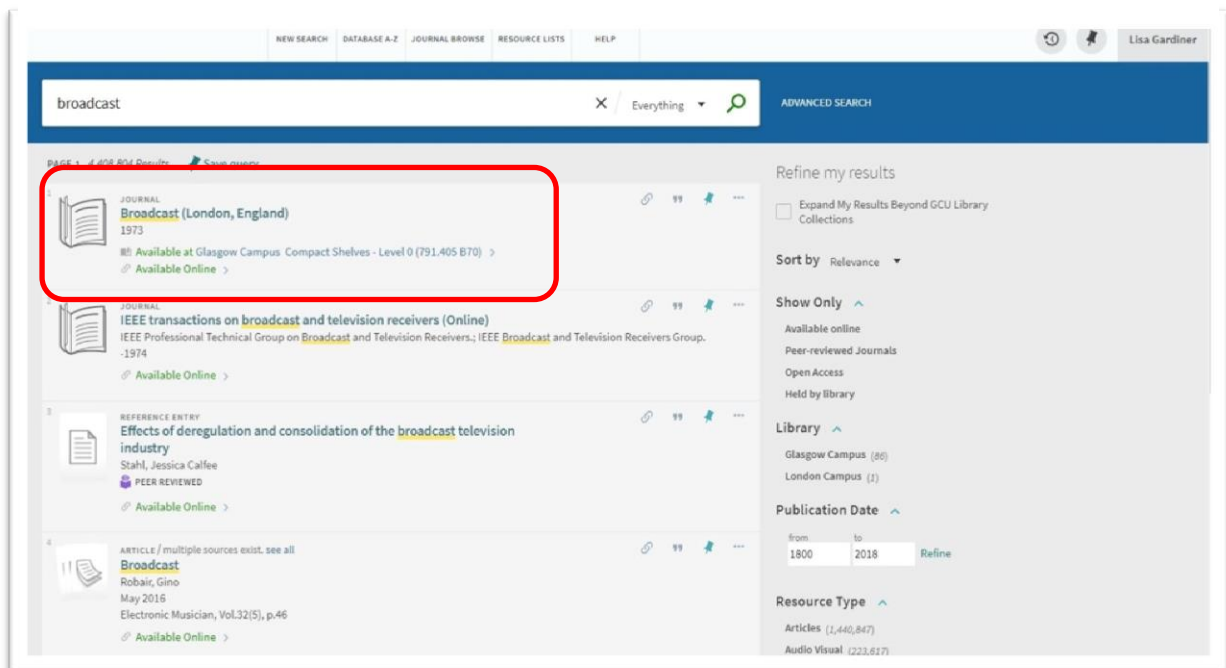
