

## TJL Environmental ISO 14001:2015 Bulletin

Welcome to TJL's first edition of our new environmental bulletin! We have introduced this bulletin which will be issued twice annually updating you on what our team have been working on and what the company has achieved. TJL environmental team consists of David Haddow, Chris Donnelly, Colin Buttar, Michael Hillman, Karen Cuthbertson, Campbell Ross and Gillian Lewis.

TJL issued their first environmental policy on 21<sup>st</sup> February 2011 and were ISO 14001 certified on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2011. We started our route for accreditation in 2010 when a small team were put together for reviewing and implementing. This involved the team reviewing any current procedures we had along with implementing new ones, all are available to view on TJL Intranet.

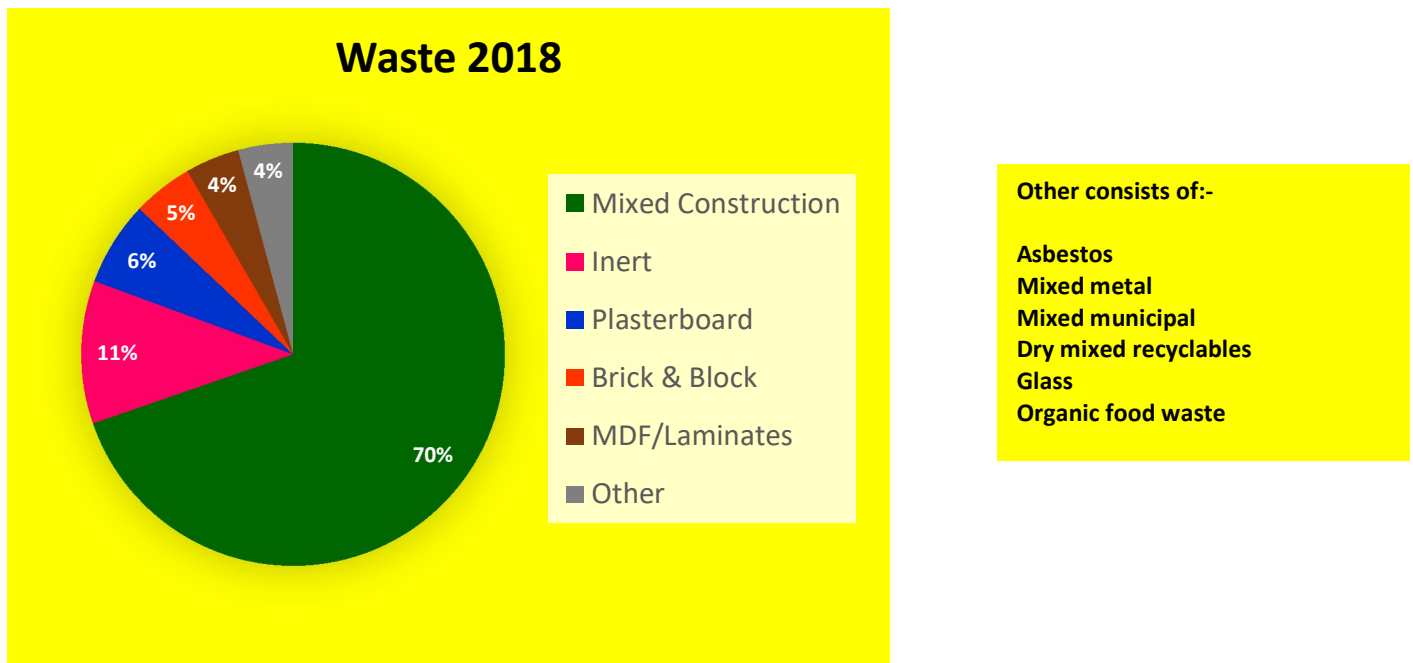
In 2018 we had to meet the new ISO 14001 standard, procedures were reviewed by the team and a transition audit was carried out by BM Trada, we successfully achieved certification to the new standard.

Throughout the 8 years there have been more than 20 environmental improvements carried out. Some examples of these improvements are; upgrading lighting to LED (with potential for all of Inchinnan/Edinburgh to be LED), electrical charging points for hybrid cars and the new extract ecogate system for the factory to name but a few.

### Company Fuel & Utilities Monitoring

With regular monitoring of our KPI's we have seen a decrease in our fuel usage from 2012 up until 2018 and we are seeing this continue into 2019.

Our electricity consumption in Inchinnan has seen a dramatic decrease. This is due to us implementing improvement plans for changing our lighting both in the offices and factory, had we not have done this then our costs would have been significantly higher. Edinburgh office has seen an increase mainly due to a rise in numbers of staff. Gas costs in both Inchinnan and Edinburgh have reduced.
