Festive Feedback 2019 Report

<u>Summary</u>

This year, Festive Feedback ran for two weeks from Monday 2nd December to Monday 30th December. Unlike last year which was a joint physical and digital campaign, this year data was only acquired using feedback tags on our Christmas tree and ran for an extra two weeks.

Library users were asked two questions:

- 1) Library Santa asks are you happy with our service this year?
- 2) Library Elf asks what would you like us to improve next year?

There were 107 responses in total, which was a marked increase from last year's 72 responses. 15 of these were removed from the final data for carrying irrelevant information such as "merry Christmas", names, twitter handles etc. so that the final total was 92.

Response Overview

The 92 responses could be separated into seven categories: Facilities (25); General Uni (8) General Library (23); IT (9); Opening Hours (4); Resources (6); Staff (17).

These could be separated into two types of feedback: Areas of Success (31) and Areas for Improvement (61).

The top areas for success were:

- Praise for staff members (10)
- Praise for general library services (10)

The top subjects in which improvements were suggested were:

- Catering options (16)
- Number of available computers (9)
- Study Spaces (9)
- Temperature issues (6)

These responses are roughly proportionate to last year given the increased amount of data but there is a notable rise in concern about study spaces -1 in 2018 as opposed to 9 in 2019.
